



2008 Titan Football Record Breakers

- After making his first catch against Denton High School, **Aaron Kirkpatrick** (running-back) went over the 100 receptions category for his high school career.
- **Antwan Mitchell** had 18 tackles against McKinney Boyd. That tied a single game record for tackles. He now shares that record with Brent Holtrop who currently starts at linebacker at Culver-Stockton University in Missouri.
- **Dominique Carroll** was named Dallas Morning News Honorable Mention Player of the Week (Zero Week) against Denton High School- he had 8 Receptions for 136 yards and two Touchdowns.
- **Brenden Grimley** set a Centennial record by making 9 PATs in the win over Denton. The previous record was held by Michael Liba with 7 PATs against Keller Central.
- **Bryan Singer** had 12 catches against McKinney Boyd. That ties a Centennial record for most catches in a single game. He shares that record with Aaron Kirkpatrick who set it during the 2006 season.
- **Ryan Mossakowski** completed 18 of 23 passes for 78% against McKinney North. That surpasses a previous record of 75% that was shared by Ryan and Crosby Butler.
- **Manual Duchane-Carroll** tied a Centennial record for most touchdown catches in a game with 3 against McKinney North. That ties a record held by Bryan Singer from 2007 also against McKinney North. For his 3 TD catches, Manual Duchane-Carroll was also named Dallas Morning News Honorable Mention Player of the Week (Week 4)
- **Imoh Edohoukwa** tied the Centennial record for interceptions in a single game. He picked off two passes against Wakeland and now shares the record with Blaine Obetz who intercepted two passes against Garland Sachse in 2006.
- **Imoh Edohoukwa** returned a kickoff 94 yards for a touchdown against Frisco Liberty. That breaks the old school record of 92 yards set by D.J. Miller in 2007 against McKinney North.
- **Brenden Grimley** set a school record by kicking a 52 yard field goal against Frisco Liberty.
